The term dysfunctional uterine bleeding (DUB) has been used previously to define a diagnosis where there was no systemic or locally definable structural cause for the abnormal bleeding (2); it is a diagnosis of exclusion not an excuse for inadequate investigation. occurs more commonly in adolescents and perimenopausal women (3).

Rarely, a thyroid problem, infection of the cervix, or cancer of the uterus can cause abnormal uterine bleeding. In most women, abnormal uterine bleeding is caused by a hormone imbalance. When hormones are the problem, doctors call the problem dysfunctional uterine bleeding, or DUB. Abnormal bleeding caused by hormone imbalance is more common in teenagers or in women who are approaching menopause.
