Questions of the survey are divided into two parts. First part is about cultural background which are grounded on the cultural studies (GLOBE, Inglehart, Schwartz, E.T. Hall and Trompenaars) in specific aspects. Personal and ethnics discrepancies will be minimized with self identification questions within the cultural background part. Second part of the questions will be related to social media usage. Social media questions consist topics such as time spending, skepticism, mobile applications, fan pages, marketer consumer activities and active & passive usage. Those topics about social media and cultural background are constructing my hypotheses in this paper. Hypotheses will be analyzed and tested in the end of this thesis. After this process, findings and further research possibilities will be discussed.
