through a regime dedicated to racial purity. Tina Campt's *Other Germans* tells the story of this largely forgotten group of individuals, with important distinctions from other accounts. In the end, the author comes face to face with an inevitable question: Is there a relationship between the history of Black Germans and those of other black communities?
