How to choose your IB subjects. Students who are taking the International Baccalaureate (IB) diploma programme are typically required to choose a course from six categories: studies in language and literature; language acquisition; individuals and societies; sciences; mathematics; and the arts. Students taking the IB are required to take at least three subjects at the higher level (HL), with the remaining classes taken at the standard level (SL).

Step 2: Find a second study for each topic: An important component of the IB Psychology essay rubric is "Use of research."
