Hubert Le Gall's work embellishes contemporary restaurants, private living spaces and the dining room of the Mayor of Paris. Since 1996 it has been displayed at the Avant-Scene gallery in Paris. Numerous pieces are now in museum collections, including the Musee des Beaux Arts in Montreal, the Musee des Arts Decoratifs in Paris and the Musee de La Piscine in Roubaix.
