It's been said that values are caught more than taught. When Polly Shivers was diagnosed with cancer in 2006, she quietly maintained, "Well, we're supposed to bloom where we are planted." Mama's words matched her actions. She knew that her six children would repeat what she did more than what she said. A Jewish single woman named Torah adopts a boy. Later in school, the boy she named Jeremiah grows fond of a priest as a father figure, who is also named Jeremiah. The church official sends Father Jeremiah away scared that his vows and oaths can be compromised by their relationship. The mother decides to find him for her son and bring him home and let him decide if he is breaking any vows or oaths, with friends in on the plan, unexpected twist and turns, and more than a few vows and oaths broken.

Selections cover three centuries of Jewish contributing voices to American letters, including those of Arthur Miller, Tillie Olsen, Bernard Malamud, Allen Ginsberg, Cynthia Ozick, and Philip Roth.

Short stories printed in the New Jersey News since 1969 under the heading Tales of Mama have been compiled by the author. They are arranged thematically and portray the shtetl, greenhorn experiences, poverty and working conditions, learning, language, humor, philosophy and the author ' s childhood. They describe a great love in a poor immigrant family that survives on the Lower East Side in spite of the difficulties of adapting in a new country. Throughout, they are sustained by a warm sense of humor that helped take the sting out of adversity.

Mary finds her long-sought-after spouse at her death, when she is united with her Eternal Bridegroom.
