The trick to remove the rear wheel on a Moto Guzzi California, or on most any motorcycle that has a standard two-sided swing-arm, is to lift the bike high enough to get the rear wheel out from under it. After considering different ways that I could lift it, I decided to just go buy an inexpensive motorcycle lift.

Remove Rear Wheel on Moto Guzzi California

If you can't get the rear wheel high enough on the centre stand to get the wheel out. Take the front wheel off first and drop it forwards carefully. This is always the main problem. Boxes and exhausts will be in the way but removable. Practise helps which will mean every nut & bolt just come apart no hassle.

Another way to dismount the rear wheel without leaning it over, if you are located on a road with a soft shoulder, is to put the bike up on the center stand on a small piece of 3/4 plywood, then dig a hole under the rear wheel large enough to allow the wheel to slip under the rear fender once the axle is out. It works.

To your wheel bearing: In theory, these are just tapped out using a rod which is a loose fit in the bearing.You have to cant it to one side to get the edge of the rod to touch the inner ring of the bearing you want to remove.
