Article 1: The nature and objectives of the game of chess. 1.1 The game of chess is played between two opponents who move their pieces alternately on a square board called a 'chessboard'. The player with the white pieces commences the game. A player is said to 'have the move', when his opponent's move has been made'. ' (See Article 6.7)
