U.S. playwright Sam Shepard is known for his interest in national myths, which he defines as mysteries that speak to the emotions and feelings of people, and in the prominence of such myths in modern society (cf. Graham 112). Thus, Shepard sees his plays as tools for cultural conversation by which he questions American myths (cf. Companion Drama 291). One of Shepard's most popular plays is the family drama *Buried Child*, which unfolds the dark secret of a family living in a farm house in Midwestern Illinois (cf. BC ).
