Guided reading is all about practice, so have students whisper read (or silently read – in late first grade and second grade) all of the words on their own. That said, some students in Kindergarten or early first grade may need more support than the book introduction in order to be successful with the text.

What are the components of a guided reading lesson in a ...

The steps for a guided reading lesson are: Before reading: Set the purpose for reading, introduce vocabulary, make predictions, talk about the strategies good readers use. During reading: Guide students as they read, provide wait time, give prompts or clues as needed by individual students, such as "Try that again.
