Life and nature are at the centre of action. Even today, the garden motif is steadily present in the literature, and it also finds a high value in children ' s literature. A prime example of a book in children ' s literature is The Secret Garden by Frances Hodgson Burnett, which was first published in 1911; it has been reissued on every occasion up until today. As the title suggests, the garden plays a central role in the book and seems to bring with it a mysterious aspect.
