This is a fascinating collection of personal accounts of operating Britain’s first V bomber by aircrew and ground crew. The book tells the story from the aircraft’s birth taking off from Vickers’s tiny airfield at Wisley near Brooklands to its premature death from fatigue. There are tales of testing atom bombs in the Australian desert, dropping hydrogen bombs in the middle of the Pacific and, as a complete contrast, attacking airfields with conventional bombs in Egypt during the very brief and abortive Suez campaign. We are reminded of how the Valiant provided the UK’s first nuclear deterrent by always having some armed aircraft on stand-by twenty-four hours a day, supported by their air and ground crews, ready to be flown at a moment’s notice on a one-way trip to launch an atomic war. Some Valiants were given a photographic role providing accurate images from high altitude and were used not only to gather military intelligence but also to survey the UK and countries overseas. Others were developed into flight refueling tankers breaking point to point records before enabling Britain’s fighter aircraft to be refueled and fly anywhere in the world. This book completes Tony Blackman’s trilogy of the three V bombers. As Marshal of the Royal Air Force Sir Michael Beetham makes it clear in his foreword: “It is good to have a book written by aircrew and ground crew telling their stories and how they operated the aircraft so that all these things are recorded and not forgotten.” Not as well known as the Vulcan and Victor, the Valiant is often overlooked; this book will go a long way to redress the balance.

We are pleased to present this LNCS volume, the Proceedings of the 22nd Australasian Joint Conference on Artificial Intelligence (AI2009), held in Melbourne, Australia, December 1–4, 2009. This long established annual regional conference is a forum both for the presentation of research advances in artificial intelligence and for scientific interchange amongst researchers and practitioners in the field of artificial intelligence. Conference attendees were also able to enjoy AI 2009 being co-located with the Australasian Data Mining Conference (AusDM 2009) and the 4th Australian Conference on Artificial Life (ACAL 2009). After an extensive peer review process where each submitted paper was rigorously reviewed by at least 2 (and in most cases 3) independent reviewers, the best 68 papers were selected by the senior Program Committee for oral presentation at the conference and included in this volume, resulting in an acceptance rate of 39%. The papers included in this volume cover a wide range of topics in artificial intelligence: from machine learning to natural language systems, from knowledge representation to soft computing, from theoretical issues to real-world applications. AI 2009 also included 11 tutorials, available through the First Australian Computational Intelligence Summer School (ACISS 2009). These tutorials – some introductory, some advanced – covered a wide range of research topics within artificial intelligence, including data mining, games, evolutionary computation, swarm optimization, intelligent agents, Bayesian and belief networks.

This book is the outcome of a colloquium series organized by The University of Sydney in which leading and emerging researchers were invited to name what they took to be the deep flaws at the heart of contemporary educational and policy and practice in Australia and globally — to voice their potentially ‘ heretical ’ views on what most urgently needs to be done. The chapters in this collection are paired to offer two takes on each topic, from supplementing to critiquing to countering and most points in between. The issues addressed in this volume include: the place of education in national and international marketplaces, mass testing and standardisation, the future of ‘ multiculturalism ’ in schools, the public funding of private schools, the complicated relationship between evidence and policy and the shifting politics of inequality.
