Through this study, the article focuses on addressing the practicalities involved in the planning and executional stages of conducting field experiments such as environment set-up and participation rates. Equally important to preplanning and design, a researcher must also be prepared to adapt and improve upon the experiment design to better fit the changing factors in the environment.
