Jen Minkman's new novella, The Waves, tells the other side of the story she began in The Island. Walt is the nephew of the Bookkeeper, the leader of the people of Hope Harbor. The residents of Walt's side of the island are waiting for their Goddess, Annabelle, to come on a ship from the Other Side and save them.

An ancient land protected by a Tower of Light, its people ever tempted by Siren song, and a girl who falls for the wrong boy. On the island of Skylge, electricity is only for the Currents – the rich ruling class who once came from across the sea and brought the holy fire of St. Brandan to Skylge. Ever since, the light in the Brandaris Tower has protected the islanders. Heeding the Siren's call will drown your body and steal your soul, but the sacred light in the Tower will chase the merfolk away.
