Now, while family and friends back home fret over her disappearance, Lou is on the run in the arctic wilderness with America's sweetheart Jack Townsend and only the contents of her purse, his pockets, and their mutual knowledge of survival movie trivia to keep them alive. Can these two children of Hollywood put aside their differences and make it back home without killing each other? Or much, much worse, actually start to like one another?

This is my autobiography and is written by me: "You will laugh with me and you will laugh at me. You will swear with me and you will swear at me. Some of you may even shed a tear when you learn about several of the people, I will introduce you to. Some of you will draw comparisons with events of your own life and on one hand be thankful for not doing some of the stupid things I have done. On the other hand, perhaps, just perhaps be disappointed for not having experienced some of the good and rewarding events I write of." My life begins in 1956. I was born in Hamilton, New Zealand. Early childhood were days of wander, adventure and excitement as I grew up in a farming community. That was soon shattered when we moved to Dunedin. I hated the place and at age nine ran away from home but was caught three days later by police in Lyttleton, approximately 400 km to the north. I had two brothers one older and one younger plus an older sister, a nice economic round figure of four. My college schooling, apprenticeship as a carpenter, falling in love, excelling as a rugby player and freestyle wrestler, throw in some sailing and boxing and yes, I loved my sport. Let's not forget to mention the finer points of altercations with the law due to fighting in the streets and in general just being a prick occupied my teen years which I spent in Nelson. My yearning for adventure and excitement first took me to Australia. Employed in a variety of jobs; Bellboy at a hotel within Sydney's Kings Cross red-light district, construction in Darwin, traveling salesman in Central Queensland just to mention only three. 1979 I found myself in the UK as a recruit in the British Parachute Regiment and with high marks I passed the P Company selection. During the following thirteen years I bounced around NZ and Australia a little like a balloon out of control but searching I guess for some form of stability. I worked a variety of jobs in cities such as Perth and Auckland, mining camps in NW Australia, deckhand on an American Tuna Purse Seiner from which I was very unceremoniously dumped and left on the shoreline. Recovered from a slight mental breakdown, rekindled a teenage romance and became engaged. Engagement collapsed after five years and so my search for myself continued. I found myself employed as a cook on a Tug Boat operating off the coast of NZ. It was here I finally found what it was that I was looking for and over the next fifteen years whilst employed by several different companies and on different oceans I worked my way up to the position of Captain. Working a roster of six weeks on and six weeks off allowed me to spend a large amount of time in Thailand and latterly Cambodia which was where I moved to after retiring from the sea, but my time in Cambodia belongs in another book. It didn't matter if it was work or play whatever I took on I had to climb the ladder to the very top. This stubborn and selfish attitude at times alienated me from friends and stopped me raising my own family. I was always the leading wolf or loan wolf but seldom part of the pack. I currently live in Thailand.

David, a fighter in the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising, escapes from the Ghetto after the fall of the Uprising. His family had perished in the death camp; but the fate of his brother Stefan, who joined the Jewish Police in the Ghetto; is unknown. David hides on the "Aryan" side with the help of his teacher and his high school friends. When the Gestapo raids his place, he escapes but is accosted by a man blackmailing Jews. David overpowers him and leaves him unconscious. He meets Morris, a Jew, who also lost his entire family. Morris goes to "Hotel Polski" and buys himself a South American visa, which would let him leave Poland and go to Switzerland. Morris is taken to the Bergen-Belsen concentration camp and the "Hotel Polski" affair turns out to be a Gestapo trap; they all are eventually killed in Auschwitz. David's joins Polish underground army and prints illegal leaflets. He takes part in the sabotage action where he kills the railroad guard and rescues a teenage brother of his friend. He has to run away again when he is about to be reported by a janitor. When the Warsaw Uprising ignites; David and his friends fight the Nazis. David witnesses a Polish MP executing a Jew falsely accused of being a Nazi spy. David meets "Renia", an Uprising runner, his first love. He finds out about the murder of several Jews by the rogue company of the Polish underground forces. He swims across the Vistula River to inform the Polish General in the Russian Army about the tragic fate of the Uprising. "Renia" is killed in action and the Uprising capitulates. The fighters are taken to POW camps and civilians to a labor camps. David escapes from Warsaw and works in a Polish field hospital as an attendant. He has to escape again; being afraid he was recognized as a Jew. He joins the partisans and is wounded in action. When the Red Army liberates the area he returns to destroyed Warsaw and meets Rebecca, the love of his live. Rebecca had become deathly ill with "blood poisoning" and David travelled illegally to Berlin to buy Penicillin to save her. The action moves to Silesia, where David's brother, Stefan, under the false name of Jan Baranski joins the communist party and hated Secret Police. He tries to hide his shameful secret from the Warsaw Ghetto. He is paranoid, unable to sleep and ends up in a hospital with the overdose of sleeping pills and alcohol. David is helping the Jews wounded in the "pogrom" in Kielce, where more then 40 Jews were killed by the Polish mob. David's best friend (who had returned from the POW camp) gets arrested by the Secret Police and dies during the interrogation. Jan Baranski is called to the Secret Police headquarter in Warsaw and finds that his brother David is alive and about to be arrested. While brothers meet, Jan advises that David should escape from Poland through the Czech border but gets furious when David calls him a Jewish Policeman. He then calls the border police and orders David's arrest. David reconsiders his plans, suspecting his brother double -crossed him. He decides to escape through the western border to Berlin and eventually to Palestine.
